○ Omaesaki Lighthouse



First lit on May 1st of 1874 and having its 150 year anniversary in 2024. The lighthouse is designated as a National Important Treasure.

◯ Ikemiya Shrine



A zen temple founded in 1283 and is said historical

Statue of Mouse



The statue was built from the old tale of the cat helped by the monk. The cat, in return, protected the monk from the attack by the evil mouse. The statue is to pray for the safety of voyage and big fish catch. 5 min walk from Omaesaki Lighthouse

◯ Omaezaki Marine Park



Seaside park located at the east of the Omaezaki Port, The promenade and observation deck are well paved and on a fine day, you can look as far as Mt. Fuji and Izu Peninsula. 5 min walk from Nabura Fish Market




